# Logline

In the wake of World War II, a wounded young veteran returns to his Cape Cod hometown to rebuild his family's failing ferry business, only to find that the tides of time—and blood—are harder to navigate than the sea.

# Series Overview

**The Sound** is a generational family drama set on Cape Cod, chronicling the McNamara family's legacy as ferry operators from the post-WWII era through the early 21st century. Told through a nonlinear structure, it explores memory, loss, reconciliation, and the pull of home.

- Set in Cape Cod (1940s–2020s)
